**NOTIFICATION**

S. O. .... Whereas B-737-300 aircraft A6-EBO of Emirates met with a serious incident of in-flight engine fire while operating flight EK 373 (BKK-DXB) on 07.11.2012.

And whereas it appears to the Central Government that it is expedient to investigate and determine the cause and contributory factors leading to the serious incident and to make recommendations to avoid reoccurrence of such serious incident in future.

Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Rule 11 (1) of the Aircraft (Investigation of Accident and Incidents) Rules, 2012, the Central Government hereby directs that an inquiry of the said serious incident be held.


The Central Government is pleased to appoint a Committee of Inquiry headed by Shri R S Passi with the following members to inquire into the circumstances of this serious incident.
