S.O. No. Whereas B 737-800 aircraft of Air India Express VT-AXE met with a serious incident at Mangalore International Airport on 14.08.2012 while operation flight IX-814 (Dubai to Mangalore).

And whereas it appears to the Central Government that it is expedient to investigate and determine the cause and contributory factors leading to the serious incident and made recommendations to avoid reoccurrence of such serious incidents in future.


