NOTIFICATION

S.O.... whereas Dauphin SA 365 N helicopter VT-ELR of M/s Pawan Hans Ltd. met with a serious incident at Andaman & Nicobar on 20.11.2013.

And whereas it appears to the Central Government that it is expedient to investigate and determine the causes and contributory factors leading to the serious incident and make recommendations to avoid reoccurrence of such serious incidents in future.

Now, in the exercise of the powers conferred by the Rules 11(1) of the Aircraft (Accident and Incident Investigation) Rules, 2012, the Central Government hereby directs that a formal inquiry of the said serious incident be held.

The Central Government is pleased to appoint a Committee of Inquiry headed by Shri S. Durairaj, Assistant Director, AAIB with following member to inquire into the circumstances of this serious incidents:

- (i) Shri K. Ramchandran, ASO, AAIB

The Committee will also take the assistance of other experts/agencies whenever required.

The headquarters of the Committee will be at New Delhi.

The Committee will complete its inquiry and submit its report to the Central Government within three months from the date of the issue of this order.
