NOTIFICATION

S.O... whereas Airbus A320 aircraft of M/s Indigo Airlines operating flight from Chandigarh to Mumbai met with a Serious Incident at Mumbai on 09-03-2013.

And whereas it appears to the Central Government that it is expedient to investigate and determine the causes and contributory factors leading to the Serious Incident and make recommendations to avoid reoccurrence of such incidents in future.

Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Rule 11 of the Aircraft (Accident and Incidents Investigation) Rules 2012, the Central Government hereby directs that a formal inquiry of the said serious incident be held.

The Central Government is pleased to appoint a Committee of Inquiry headed by Sh. R S Passi, DDAS, AAIB with following members to inquire into the circumstances of this serious incident.



Central Government also approves Ms. Shilpy Satiya, ASO, AAIB as Secretary to the Committee of Inquiry.

The Committee will complete its inquiry and submit its report to the Central Government within three months.
