**NOTIFICATION**

S.O. ...whereas Airbus A319 aircraft VT-SCL of M/s Air India operating flight from Abu Dhabi to Mumbai met with a Serious Incident (Landed without ATC permission) at Mumbai on 12.04.2013.

And whereas it appears to the Central Government that it is expedient to investigate and determine the causes and contributory factors leading to the Serious Incident and make recommendations to avoid reoccurrence of such incidents in future.

Now, in exercise of powers conferred by the Rule 11 of the Aircraft (Accident and Incidents Investigation) Rules, 2012, the Central Government hereby directs that a formal inquiry of the said serious incident be held.

The Central Government is pleased to appoint a Committee of Inquiry headed by Shri R.S. Passi, DDAS, AAIB with following members to inquire into the circumstances of this Serious Incident.

1. Shri N.S. Dagar, Jt.GM (ATM), AAIB/AAI
2. Capt. Nitin Anand, FOI, DGCA

The Committee will also take the assistance of other experts/agencies whenever required.

The headquarters of the Committee will be at New Delhi.

The Committee will complete its inquiry and submit its report to the Central Government within three months.
