**NOTIFICATION**

S.O. whereas Cessna 152 aircraft VT-CAX of M/s Trans Bharat operating flight from Ranchi to Fursatganj met with an Accident near Fursatganj airfield on 20.03.2014.

And whereas, it appears to the Central Government that it is expedient to investigate and determine the causes and contributory factors leading to the Accident and make recommendations to avoid recurrence of such accidents in future.

Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Rule 11(1) of the Aircraft (Investigation of Accidents and Incidents) Rules, 2012, the Central Government hereby directs that a formal inquiry of the accident be held.

The Central Government is pleased to appoint a Committee of Inquiry headed by Shri Amit Gupta, Deputy Director-AED, AAIB with the following member to inquire into the circumstances of the accident:

- (i) Ms. Shilpy Satiya, Air Safety Officer, AAIB

The Committee will also take the assistance of other experts/agencies whenever required.

The headquarters of the Committee will be at New Delhi.

The Committee will complete its inquiry and submit its report to the Central Government preferably within six months from the date of issue of this order.
