**NOTIFICATION**

S.O.... whereas M/s Spice Jet aircraft B 737-800 aircraft VT-SGK was involved in an accident on 06.11.2014 at Surat while carrying out a scheduled flight SG-622 from Surat to Delhi.

And whereas, it appears to the Central Government that it is expedient to investigate and determine the causes and contributory factors leading to the said accident and make recommendations to avoid recurrence of such accident in future.

Now, in the exercise of the powers conferred by the Rules 11(1) of the Aircraft (Investigation of Accidents and Incidents) Rules, 2012, the Central Government hereby directs that a formal inquiry of the said accident be held.

The Central Government is pleased to appoint a Committee of Inquiry headed by Shri R.S. Passi, Deputy Director, AAIB with the following members:

- (i) Shri K. Ramachandran, Air Safety Officer, AAIB

The Committee will also take the assistance of other experts/agencies whenever required.

The headquarters of the Committee will be at New Delhi.

The Committee will complete its inquiry and submit its report to the Central Government preferably within three months
