NOTIFICATION

S.O...whereas, Ecureuil AS350 BA Helicopter VT- MAB of M/s MESCO Airlines Ltd. while carrying out flight from Muradnagar (U.P) to Manak Mau (U.P) met with a Serious Incident at Chakvali Village near Saharanpur on 08.04.2014.

And whereas, it appears to the Central Government that it is expedient to investigate and determine the cause and contributory factors leading to the Serious Incident and make recommendation to prevent recurrence of such serious incidents in future.

Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Rule 11 (1) of the Aircraft (Investigation of Accidents and Incidents) Rules 2012, the Central Government hereby directs that a formal inquiry of the said serious incident be conducted.


In pursuance of the aforementioned, the Central Government is pleased to appoint a Committee of Inquiry headed by Sh. Amit Gupta, Deputy Director - AED, AAIB with following members to inquire into the circumstances of this serious incident:

- (i) Capt. S K S Panwar, FOI, DGCA
- (ii) Sh. K Ramachandran, ASO, AAIB

The committee can also take the assistance of other experts/agencies whenever required for or during the course of conducting the enquiry.

The headquarters of the Committee will be at New Delhi.

The Committee shall complete its inquiry and submit its report to the Central Government, preferably within six months of this notification.
