NOTIFICATION

S.O....whereas, Boeing 737-8GJ(WL) Aircraft VT-SZD of M/s Spicejet Ltd. operating flight from Mumbai to Hyderabad met with a Serious Incident of Pilot-Incapacitation during flight at Hyderabad on 08.01.2014.

And whereas, it appears to the Central Government that it is expedient to investigate and determine the causes and contributory factors leading to the serious incident and make recommendations to avoid reoccurrence of such incidents in future.

Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Rule 11(1) of the Aircraft (Investigation of Accidents and Incidents) Rules, 2012, the Central Government hereby directs that a formal inquiry of the said serious incident be held.


The Central Government is pleased to appoint a Committee of Inquiry headed by Air Cmde (Dr.) Harish Malik (Retd.) with following member to inquire into the circumstances of the serious incident.

The Committee will also take the assistance of other experts/agencies whenever required.

The headquarters of the Committee will be at New Delhi.

The Committee will complete its inquiry and submit its report to the Central Government preferably within six months from the date of issue of this Notification.
