S.O.... Whereas M/s Jet Airways Ltd. Boeing B737-800 aircraft VT-JGA was involved in an accident on 13.04.2015 at Khajuraho.

And whereas, it appears to the Central Government that it is expedient to investigate and determine the causes and contributory factors leading to the said accident and make recommendations to avoid recurrence of such accidents in future.

Now, in the exercise of the powers conferred by the Rules 11(1) of the Aircraft (Investigation of Accidents and Incidents) Rules, 2012, the Central Government hereby directs that a formal inquiry of the said accident be held.

The Central Government is pleased to appoint a Committee of Inquiry headed by Shri Amit Gupta, Deputy Director, AED, AAIB with the following members:
