S.O.... Whereas ZENAIR STOL CH 701 Microlight aircraft VT-USO belonging to Shri Santosh K. Sharma and Shri C.S. Ramesh Rao met with an accident on 02.05.2015 at Bengurkoli, Coorg district on 02.05.2015.

And whereas, it appears to the Central Government that it is expedient to investigate and determine the causes and contributory factors leading to the said accident and make recommendations to avoid recurrence of such accidents in future.

Now, in the exercise of the powers conferred by the Rules 11(1) of the Aircraft (Investigation of Accidents and Incidents) Rules, 2012, the Central Government hereby directs that a formal inquiry of the said accident be held.

The Central Government is pleased to appoint a Committee of Inquiry headed by Shri K. Ramachandran, Air Safety Officer, AAIB as Chairman with the following members
