S.O.... whereas M/s Air India A321 aircraft VT-PPD, while operating flight AI-680 was involved in a serious incident at Mumbai on 15.02.2015.

And whereas, it appears to the Central Government that it is expedient to investigate and determine the causes and contributory factors leading to the said serious incident and make recommendations to avoid recurrence of such serious incidents in future.

Now, in the exercise of the powers conferred by the Rules 11 of the Aircraft (Investigation of Accidents and Incidents) Rules, 2012, the Central Government hereby directs that a formal inquiry of the said accident be held.

The Central Government is pleased to appoint a Committee of Inquiry headed by Shri A.X. Jospeh, Deputy Director, AAIB with the following member:

- (i) Capt. Nitin Anand Member

The Committee will also take the assistance of other experts/agencies whenever required.

The headquarters of the Committee will be at New Delhi.

The Committee will complete its inquiry and submit its report to the Central Government preferably within six months
