ORDER –Accident

Whereas Cessna 172 S aircraft VT-ABK, of M/s Ahmedabad Aviation & Aeronautics Ltd., while operating a training flight met with an accident at Mehsana Airport, Gujrat, India, on 24.11.2018.

And, whereas it appears to the Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau (AAIB), India that it is expedient to investigate and determine the probable cause(s) and contributory factor(s) leading to the accident and make recommendations to avoid recurrence of such accident in future.

Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Rule 11 (1) of the Aircraft (Investigation of Accidents and Incidents) Rules 2017, the Director General-AAIB, India hereby directs an Investigation of the said accident for the probable cause(s).

The Director General-AAIB, India hereby appoints Sh. K. Ramachandran, Assistant Director, AAIB as Investigator – in – Charge. He will be assisted by Sh. Dinesh Kumar, Air Safety Officer to inquire into the circumstances of this accident.

The Investigator-in-Charge will take the assistance of other experts/agencies whenever required.

The headquarters of the Investigation will be at New Delhi.

The Investigator-in-Charge will complete its inquiry and submit the report to AAIB, India, preferably within ten months from the date of issue of this order.
