ORDER - Accident

Whereas Cessna 208 B aircraft VT-UDN of M/s Supreme Transport Organization Pvt. Ltd, while operating flight from Jaipur to Lalgah Airstrip, Rajasthan met with an accident on 07th of August 2018.

And, whereas it appears to the Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau (AAIB), India that it is expedient to investigate and determine the probable cause(s) and contributory factor(s) leading to the accident and make recommendations to avoid reoccurrence of such accidents in future.

Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Rule 11 (1) of the Aircraft (Accident and Incidents Investigation) Rules 2017, the Director General-AAIB, India hereby directs an Investigation of the said accident for the probable cause(s).

The Director General-AAIB, India is pleased to appoint Sh. R S Passi, Director, AAIB as Investigator - in - Charge. He will be assisted by Ms. Shilpy Satiya Assistant Director, AAIB to inquire into the circumstances of this accident.

The Investigator-in-Charge may also take the assistance of other experts/agencies whenever required.

The headquarters of the Investigation will be at New Delhi.

The Investigator-in-Charge will complete its inquiry and submit the report to AAIB, India, preferably within six months from the date of issue of this order.
