ORDER – Serious Incident

Whereas Boeing 777 aircraft VT-ALN of M/s Air India, while operating flight AI864 was involved in a serious incident at Mumbai on 15th of October 2018.

And, whereas it appears to the Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau (AAIB), India that it is expedient to investigate and determine the probable cause(s) and contributory factor(s) leading to the serious incident and make recommendations to avoid reoccurrence of such serious incident in future.

Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Rule 11 (1) of the Aircraft (Accident and Incidents Investigation) Rules 2017, the Director General-AAIB, India hereby directs an Investigation of the said accident for the probable cause(s).

The Director General-AAIB, India is pleased to appoint Mr. Jasbir Singh Larhga, Assistant Director, AAIB as Investigator – in – Charge. He will be assisted by the following investigator(s) to inquire into the circumstances of this serious incident.

The Investigator-in-Charge will take the assistance of other experts/agencies whenever required.

The headquarters of the Investigation will be at New Delhi.

The Investigator-in-Charge will complete its inquiry and submit the report to AAIB, India, preferably within ten months from the date of issue of this order.
