**ORDER – Serious Incident**

Whereas Airbus A320 aircraft VT-ITR, of M/s Indigo, while operating a scheduled flight for sector Jaipur-Kolkata, met with a serious incident at Kolkata on 10<sup>th</sup> of December 2018.

And, whereas it appears to the Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau (AAIB), India that it is expedient to investigate and determine the probable cause(s) and contributory factor(s) leading to the serious incident and make recommendations to avoid recurrence of such incident in future.

Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Rule 11 (1) of the Aircraft (Accident and Incidents Investigation) Rules 2017, the Director General-AAIB, India hereby orders an Investigation of the said serious incident to find out the probable cause(s).


The Director General-AAIB, India hereby appoints Sh. R S Passi, Director, AAIB as Investigator – in – Charge. He will be assisted by Sh. K Ramachandran, Assistant Director, AAIB as Investigator to inquire into the circumstances of this serious incident.

Sh. Anil Tewari, Director, AAIB will be on OJT.

The Investigator-in-Charge may take the assistance of other experts/agencies whenever required.

The headquarters of the Investigation will be at New Delhi.

The Investigator-in-Charge will complete its inquiry and submit the report to AAIB, India, preferably within ten months from the date of issue of this order.
