ORDER No. 04/2018- Serious Incident

Whereas ATR 72-212A-600 aircraft VT-IYD of M/s Indigo, while operating flight from Tirupati to Hyderabad met with a serious incident on 28th March 2018.

And, whereas it appears to the Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau (AAIB), India that it is expedient to investigate and determine the probable cause(s) and contributory factor(s) leading to the serious incident and make recommendations to avoid reoccurrence of such serious incidents in future.

Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Rule 11 (1) of the Aircraft (Accident and Incidents Investigation) Rules 2017, the Director General-AAIB, India hereby directs an Investigation of the said serious incident for the probable cause(s).

The Director General-AAIB, India is pleased to appoint Sh. R S Passi, Deputy Director, AAIB as Investigator - in - Charge. He will be assisted by the Ms. Shilpy Satiya, Air Safety Officer, AAIB as investigator to inquire into the circumstances of this serious incident.

The Investigator-in-Charge may also take the assistance of other experts/agencies whenever required.

The headquarters of the Investigation will be at New Delhi.

The Investigator-in-Charge will complete its inquiry and submit the report to AAIB, India, preferably within six months from the date of issue of this order.
