**ORDER – Serious Incident**

Whereas an Airprox incident occurred between NCR840 (Bagram to Hong Kong), KLM875 (Amsterdam to Suvarnabhumi) and EVA061 (Suvarnabhumi to Vienna) on 22/12/2018 in Delhi control airspace.

And, whereas it appears to the Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau (AAIB), India that it is expedient to investigate and determine the probable cause(s) and contributory factor(s) leading to the serious incident and make recommendations to avoid recurrence of such incident in future.

Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Rule 11 (1) of the Aircraft (Accident and Incidents Investigation) Rules 2017, the Director General-AAIB, India hereby orders an Investigation of the said serious incident to find out the probable cause(s).

The Director General-AAIB, India hereby appoints Sh. Jasbir Singh Larhga, Assistant Director, AAIB as Investigator – in – Charge. He will be assisted by Ms. Kunj Lata, Assistant Director, AAIB and Capt. Gaurav Pathak as Investigators to inquire into the circumstances of this serious incident.

The Investigator-in-Charge may take the assistance of other experts/agencies whenever required.

The headquarters of the Investigation will be at New Delhi.

The Investigator-in-Charge will complete its inquiry and submit the report to AAIB, India, preferably within ten months from the date of issue of this order.
