ORDER – Serious Incident

Whereas Airbus A320 (Neo) aircraft VT-ITG, of M/s Indigo, while operating a scheduled flight for sector Pune - Nagpur, met with a serious incident at Pune on 02nd of April 2019.

And, whereas prima - facie it appears to the Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau (AAIB), India, that the occurrence is similar to the serious incident to Airbus A320 (Neo) aircraft, of M/s Indigo, at Chennai on 03rd of January 2019, being investigated by an IIC.

Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Rule 11 (1) of the Aircraft (Accident and Incidents Investigation) Rules 2017, the Director General-AAIB, India hereby orders an Investigation of the said serious incident to find out the probable cause(s), along with investigation of serious incident to Airbus A320 (Neo) aircraft VT-ITW, of M/s Indigo, at Chennai on 03rd of January 2019.

The Director General-AAIB, India hereby appoints Sh. Jasbir Singh Larhga, Assistant Director, AAIB as Investigator – in – Charge. He will be assisted by Sh. K Ramachandran, Assistant Director, AAIB as Investigator to inquire into the circumstances of this serious incident.

Sh. Amit Kumar, Safety Investigation Officer, AAIB will be on OJT.

The Investigator-in-Charge may take the assistance of other experts/agencies whenever required.

The headquarters of the Investigation will be at New Delhi.

The findings/observations of this investigation may be incorporated in the investigation report of serious incident to Airbus A320 (Neo) aircraft VT-ITW, of M/s Indigo, at Chennai on 03rd of January 2019.
