ORDER – Serious Incident

Whereas Airbus A320 aircraft VT-WJE and VT-WGL of M/s Go Air, while operating scheduled flights met with serious incidents on 22nd & 23rd of December 2019 respectively.

And, whereas prima - facie it appears to the Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau (AAIB), India, that these occurrences are similar type of serious incidents to Airbus A320 aircraft, and it is expedient to investigate and determine the probable cause(s) and contributory factor(s) leading to the serious incident and make recommendation(s) to avoid recurrence of such incident in future.


Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Rule 11 (1) of the Aircraft (Accident and Incidents Investigation) Rules 2017, the Director General-AAIB, India hereby orders an Investigation of the said serious incidents to find out the probable cause(s).

The Director General-AAIB, India hereby appoints Sh. Jasbir Singh Larhga, Assitant Director, AAIB as Investigator-in-Charge. He will be assisted by Sh. Amit Kumar, Safety Investigation Officer, AAIB as Investigator to inquire into the circumstances of these serious incidents.

The Investigator-in-Charge may take the assistance of other experts/agencies whenever required.

The headquarters of the Investigation will be at New Delhi.

The Investigator-in-Charge will complete its inquiry and submit the report to AAIB, India, preferably within four months from the date of issue of this order.
