**ORDER – Serious Incident**

Whereas Airbus A320 (Neo) aircraft VT-IVX, VT-ITA, VT-IZT and VT-ITM of M/s Indigo, while operating a scheduled flight met with serious incident on 24<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup>, 26<sup>th</sup> & 30<sup>th</sup> of October 2019 respectively.

And, whereas prima - facie it appears to the Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau (AAIB), India, that these occurrences are similar to the earlier serious incidents to Airbus A320 (Neo) aircraft, of M/s Indigo, which are being investigated by an IIC.

The Investigator-In-Charge, pending the full investigation of subject serious incidents will carry out investigation into the operational & training aspects including procedures and suggest preventive measures, if any in this regard.

Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Rule 11 (1) of the Aircraft (Accident and Incidents Investigation) Rules 2017, the Director General-AAIB, India hereby orders an Investigation of the said serious incidents to find out the probable cause(s).

The Director General-AAIB, India hereby appoints Sh. R S Passi, Director, AAIB as Investigator – in – Charge. He will be assisted by Sh. K Ramachandran, Assistant Director, AAIB as Investigator to inquire into the circumstances of these serious incidents.

The Investigator-in-Charge may take the assistance of other experts/agencies whenever required.

The headquarters of the Investigation will be at New Delhi.

The findings/observations of these investigations may be incorporated in a single investigation report of serious incident to Airbus A320 (Neo) aircraft VT-IVX, of M/s Indigo, which occurred on 24<sup>th</sup> of October 2019.

The Investigator-in-Charge will complete its inquiry and submit the report to AAIB, India, preferably within six months from the date of issue of this order.
