**ORDER – Serious Incident**

Whereas A-320 aircraft VT-TNH, of M/s Vistara, while operating a scheduled flight for sector Mumbai to Delhi, diverted to Lucknow and met with a serious incident on 15<sup>th</sup> of July 2019. Another A-320 aircraft VT-TTN of M/s Vistara Ltd. was involved in similar serious incident while operating flight from Srinagar –Jammu, diverted to Amritsar on 04<sup>th</sup> July 2019

And, whereas it appears to the Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau (AAIB), India that it is expedient to investigate and determine the probable cause(s) and contributory factor(s) leading to the serious incidents and make recommendations to avoid recurrence of such incidents in future.


Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Rule 11 (1) of the Aircraft (Accident and Incidents Investigation) Rules 2017, the Director General-AAIB, India hereby orders an Investigation of the said serious incidents to find out the probable cause(s).

The Director General-AAIB, India hereby appoints Mr. R S Passi, Director, AAIB as Investigator – in – Charge. He will be assisted by Ms. Shilpy Satiya, Assistant Director, AAIB as Investigator to inquire into the circumstances of the serious incidents.

The Investigator-in-Charge may take the assistance of other experts/agencies whenever required.

The headquarters of the Investigation will be at New Delhi.

The Investigator-in-Charge will complete its inquiry and submit the report to AAIB, India, preferably within three months from the date of issue of this order.
