ORDER - Accident

Whereas Cessna 152 aircraft VT-ENF, of M/s Govt. Aviation Training Institute, while operating training flight from Birasal Airstrip, Bhubaneswar, India, met with an accident on 8th Jun 2020.

And, whereas it appears to the Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau (AAIB), India that it is expedient to investigate and determine the probable cause(s) and contributory factor(s) leading to the accident and make recommendations to avoid recurrence of such accident in future.

Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Rule 11 (1) of the Aircraft (Accident and Incidents Investigation) Rules 2017, the Director General-AAIB, India hereby orders an investigation of the said accident to find out the probable cause(s).

The Director General-AAIB, India hereby appoints Sh. Jasbir Singh Larhga, Deputy Director, AAIB as Investigator – in – Charge. He will be assisted by Sh. Dinesh Kumar, Air Safety Officer, AAIB as investigator to inquire into the circumstances of this accident.

The Investigator-in-Charge may take the assistance of other experts/agencies whenever required.

The headquarters of the investigation will be at New Delhi.

The Investigator-in-Charge will complete its inquiry and submit the report to AAIB, India, preferably within five months from the date of issue of this order.
