ORDER – SERIOUS INCIDENT

Whereas Airbus A321 aircraft VT-PPU of M/s Air India Ltd was involved in a Serious Incident on 15thFeb 2020 at Pune Airport.

And, whereas prima - facie it appears to the Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau (AAIB) that it is expedient to investigate and determine the probable cause(s) and contributory factor(s) leading to this serious incident and make recommendation(s) to avoid recurrence of such incident in future.


Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Rule 11 (1) of the Aircraft (Accident and Incidents Investigation) Rules 2017, the Director General-AAIB, India hereby orders an investigation of the said serious incident to find out the probable cause(s).

The Director General-AAIB, India hereby appoints Mr. Anil Tewari, Director, AAIB as Investigator – in – Charge. He will be assisted by Ms. Kunj Lata, Assistant Director, AAIB as Investigator to inquire into the circumstances of this Serious Incident.

The Investigator-in-Charge will take the assistance of Air force official(s) and other experts / agencies whenever required.

The headquarters of the investigation will be at New Delhi.

The Investigator-in-Charge will complete its inquiry and submit the report to AAIB, India, preferably within three months from the date of issue of this order.
