**ORDER – Serious Incident**

Whereas Boeing 737 aircraft VT-SZK, of M/s Spice Jet Limited, while operating a scheduled flight SEJ467 from Mumbai to Hyderabad landed on an unassigned runway on 20th Jan 2020.


Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Rule 11 (1) of the Aircraft (Accident and Incidents Investigation) Rules 2017, the Director General-AAIB, India hereby orders an investigation of the said serious incident to find out the probable cause(s).

The Director General-AAIB, India hereby appoints Sh. R.S. Passi, Director, AAIB as Investigator – in – Charge. He will be assisted by Ms. Kunjlata, Asst. Director, AAIB as investigator to inquire into the circumstances of this serious incident.

The Investigator-in-Charge may take the assistance of other experts/agencies whenever required.

The headquarters of the investigation will be at New Delhi.

The Investigator-in-Charge will complete its inquiry and submit the report to AAIB, India, preferably within three months from the date of issue of this order.
