ORDER – Serious Incident

Whereas Airbus A320 (NEO) aircraft VT-WGC, of M/s Go Airlines (India) Limited, while operating Schedule flight G8 186 from Delhi to Varanasi was involved in an emergency landing due to engine failure on 7th Jan 2020.

And, whereas prima - facie it appears to the Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau (AAIB), India, that this occurrence is a similar type of serious incident to Airbus A320 aircraft, which are being investigated by AAIB as per Order-Serious Incident, file No. 12011/25/2019-AAIB, dated 23rd Dec 2019 and it is expedient to investigate and determine the probable cause(s) and contributory factor(s) leading to the serious incident and make recommendation(s) to avoid recurrence of such incident in future.


Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Rule 11 (1) of the Aircraft (Accident and Incidents Investigation) Rules 2017, the Director General-AAIB, India hereby orders an investigation of the said serious incident to find out the probable cause(s).

The Director General-AAIB, India hereby appoints Sh. Jasbir Singh Larhga, Deputy Director, AAIB as Investigator – in – Charge. He will be assisted by Sh. Amit Kumar, Safety Investigation Officer, AAIB as investigator to inquire into the circumstances of this accident.

The Investigator-in-Charge may take the assistance of other experts/agencies whenever required.

The headquarters of the investigation will be at New Delhi.

The Investigator-in-Charge will complete its inquiry and submit the report to AAIB, India, preferably within four months from the date of issue of this order.
