**ORDER – Incident**

Whereas McDonnell Douglas MD-11 aircraft Regn. N583FE, of M/s Fedex, while operating flight FDX5033 for sector Bengaluru - Mumbai, met with an incident at Mumbai on 03<sup>rd</sup> of June 2020.

And, whereas it appears to the Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau (AAIB), India that it is expedient to investigate and determine the probable cause(s) and contributory factor(s) leading to the incident and make recommendations to avoid recurrence of such incident in future.


Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Rule 5(2) of the Aircraft (Accident and Incidents Investigation) Rules 2017, the Director General-AAIB, India hereby orders an Investigation of the said incident to find out the probable cause(s).

The Director General-AAIB, India hereby appoints Sh. R S Passi, Director, AAIB as Investigator – in – Charge. He will be assisted by Capt. Gaurav Pathak, Operations Expert as Investigator to inquire into the circumstances of this incident.

The Investigator-in-Charge may take the assistance of other experts/agencies whenever required.

The headquarters of the Investigation will be at New Delhi.

The Investigator-in-Charge will complete its inquiry and submit the report to AAIB, India, preferably within three months from the date of issue of this order.
