**ORDER – SERIOUS INCIDENT**

Whereas Airbus A320 aircraft VT-IAR of M/s Indigo and Airbus A320 aircraft VT-CCU of M/s Air Asia were involved in a Serious Incident on 29<sup>th</sup> Feb 2020 at Delhi Airport.

And, whereas prima - facie it appears to the Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau (AAIB) that it is expedient to investigate and determine the probable cause(s) and contributory factor(s) leading to this serious incident and make recommendation(s) to avoid recurrence of such incident in future.


Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Rule 11 (1) of the Aircraft (Accident and Incidents Investigation) Rules 2017, the Director General-AAIB, India hereby orders an investigation of the said serious incident to find out the probable cause(s).

The Director General-AAIB, India hereby appoints Ms. Kunj Lata, Assistant Director, AAIB as Investigator – in – Charge. She will be assisted by Mr. Amit Kumar, Safety Investigation Officer, AAIB as Investigator to inquire into the circumstances of this Serious Incident.

The Investigator-in-Charge may take the assistance experts/agencies whenever required.

The headquarters of the investigation will be at New Delhi.

The Investigator-in-Charge will complete its inquiry and submit the report to AAIB, India, preferably within one month from the date of issue of this order.
