ORDER

Whereas Technam P-2008JC aircraft VT-RBE of M/s Redbird Flight Training Academy, met with an accident at Baramati, Maharashtra, while landing after a solo training flight , on 20th Sep 2021.


And, whereas it appears to the Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau (AAIB), India that it is expedient to investigate and determine the probable cause(s) and contributory factor(s) leading to this accident and make recommendations to avoid recurrence of such an accident in future.

Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Rule 11 (1) of the Aircraft (Accident and Incidents Investigation) Rules 2017 read with Aircraft (Accident and Incidents Investigation) Amendment Rules, 2021; the undersigned hereby orders an investigation of the said accident to find out the probable cause(s) and appoints Sh. Amit Kumar, AAIB as Investigator – in – Charge (IIC) to inquire into the circumstances leading to this accident.

The Investigator-in-Charge may take the assistance of other experts/agencies whenever required.

The headquarters of this Investigation will be at New Delhi.

The Investigator-in-Charge will complete this investigation and submit the Final Investigation Report to AAIB, India, preferably within two months from the date of issue of this order.
