ORDER

Whereas Boeing 737-800 aircraft VT-TGE of M/s TATA SIA Airlines Ltd was involved in an accident near Kolkata while operating a scheduled flight from Mumbai to Kolkata, on 07th Jun 2021.


And, whereas it appears to the Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau (AAIB), India that it is expedient to investigate and determine the probable cause(s) and contributory factor(s) leading to this accident and make recommendations to avoid recurrence of such accident in future.

Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Rule 11 (1) of the Aircraft (Accident and Incidents Investigation) Rules 2017 read with Aircraft (Accident and Incidents Investigation) Amendment Rules, 2021; the undersigned hereby orders an investigation of the said accident to find out the probable cause(s) and appoints Ms Shilpy Satiya, Assistant Director, AAIB as Investigator – in – Charge (IIC). She will be assisted by Sh Dinesh Kumar, Assistant Director, AAIB as investigator to inquire into the circumstances leading to this accident.

The Investigator-in-Charge may take the assistance of other experts/agencies whenever required.

The headquarters of the Investigation will be at New Delhi.

The Investigator-in-Charge will complete this investigation and submit the Final Investigation Report to AAIB, India, preferably within five months from the date of issue of this order.
