ORDER

Whereas B200 aircraft VT-MPQ of Madhya Pradesh Government, while operating a flight from Indore to Gwalior met with an accident at Gwalior Airport on 06th May 2021.


And, whereas it appears to the Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau (AAIB), India that it is expedient to investigate and determine the probable cause(s) and contributory factor(s) leading to the accident and make recommendations to avoid recurrence of such accident in future.

Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Rule 11 (1) of the Aircraft (Accident and Incidents Investigation) Rules 2017, the undersigned, India hereby orders an Investigation of the said accident to find out the probable cause(s) and appoints Capt Dhruv Rebbapragada as Investigator – in – Charge (IIC). He will be assisted by Sh. Rohith Mithai, Asst Director (Air Safety), DAS(WR), DGCA and Sh Dinesh Kumar, Asst Director, AAIB as Investigators to inquire into the circumstances leading to this accident.

The Investigator-in-Charge may take the assistance of other experts/agencies whenever required.

The headquarters of the Investigation will be at New Delhi.

The Investigator-in-Charge will complete this investigation and submit the Final Investigation Report to AAIB, India, preferably within five months from the date of issue of this order.
