**ORDER – Serious Incident**

Whereas Airbus A320 aircraft VT-IMP of M/s Air Asia and Airbus A320 aircraft VT-IAL of M/s Indigo were involved in a Serious Incident of Airprox in Mumbai air space on 29<sup>th</sup> Jan 2021.

And, whereas it appears to the Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau (AAIB), India that it is expedient to investigate and determine the probable cause(s) and contributory factor(s) leading to the incident and make recommendations to avoid recurrence of such incident in future.


Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Rule 11 (1) of the Aircraft (Accident and Incidents Investigation) Rules 2017, the Director General-AAIB, India hereby orders an Investigation of the said incident to find out the probable cause(s).

The Director General-AAIB, India hereby appoints Ms. Kunj Lata, Assistant Director, AAIB as Investigator – in – Charge. She will be assisted by Sh. Amit Kumar, Safety Investigation Officer, AAIB as Investigator to inquire into the circumstances of this incident.

The Investigator-in-Charge may take the assistance of other experts/agencies whenever required.

The headquarters of the Investigation will be at New Delhi.

The Investigator-in-Charge will complete its investigation and submit the final report to AAIB, India, preferably within four months from the date of issue of this order.
