**ORDER**

Whereas DASH8 Q400 aircraft VT-SUW of M/s SpiceJet Ltd, met with a serious incident at Delhi, while operating a scheduled flight from Gorakhpur to Delhi, on 22nd Nov 2021.


And, whereas it appears to the Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau (AAIB), India that it is expedient to investigate and determine the probable cause(s) and contributory factor(s) leading to this serious incident and make recommendations to avoid recurrence of such a serious incident in future.

Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Rule 11 (1) of the Aircraft (Accident and Incidents Investigation) Rules 2017 read with Aircraft (Accident and Incidents Investigation) Amendment Rules, 2021; the undersigned hereby orders an investigation of the said serious incident to find out the probable cause(s) and appoints Sh. K. Ramachandran, Assistant Director, AAIB as Investigator – in – Charge. He will be assisted by Sh. Amit Kumar, Safety Investigation Officer, AAIB to inquire into the circumstances leading to this serious incident.

The Investigator-in-Charge may take the assistance of other experts/agencies whenever required.

The headquarters of this Investigation will be at New Delhi.

The Investigator-in-Charge will complete this investigation and submit the Final Investigation Report to AAIB, India, preferably within three months from the date of issue of this order.
